About the Show

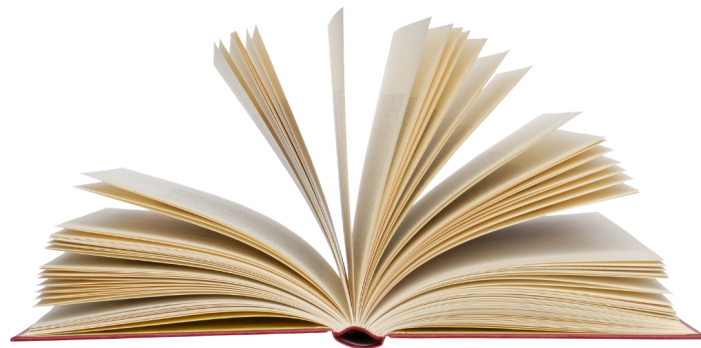

Premiering February 12th and streaming until February 21st via YouTube. Join us as we bring one of literature's most romantic stories to life!

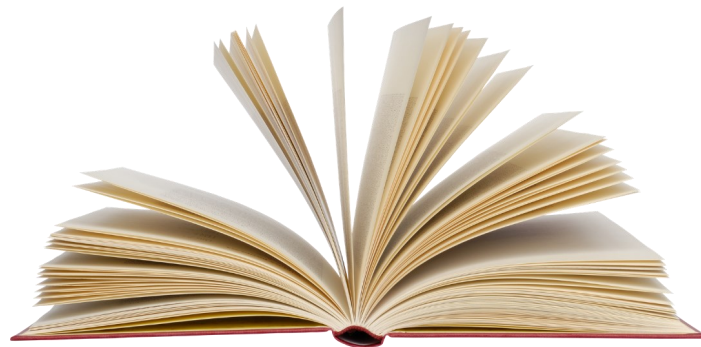
