Director's Note

We all have become weary of the term "unprecedented times", I for one have hit the point of this pandemic that I very much long for "precedented" anything, any amount of normalcy. However, to meet the moment and stage our production of 9 to 5 we had to not only acknowledge how unprecedented the challenges were before us, but use the creativity and ingenuity of our entire community to rise to those challenges. The show you will see tonight defies any rehearsal process and production requirements I have ever known in my nine years as drama club advisor.

Our rehearsal process started virtually, with auditions and interviews happening via the video chat platforms that have become so commonplace in our lives. Students learned music and recorded their vocals as we endeavored to record a full cast recording of our show. Tonight you will see a balance of live sung and recorded performances our musical director Anna Wentlent and our cast worked tirelessly on.

Choreography by Ms. Katie Donovan was taught primarily via video recording, and from the small screens of our laptops and devices, turning bedrooms, dining rooms and garages into make shift dance studios.

Mrs. Erline Trites and costume crew member Laura Yatsuhashi created an entire costume design virtually. Having to landscape the visual elements of our show completely in their imagination, and luckily for us those are imaginations for the record books.

In order to teach the blocking of our socially distance required performance, I used sidewalk chalk, painting lights and a lot of extension cords to turn my very own driveway into pseudo stage, broadcasting to each cast and crew member as I danced and walked through each number and they followed along at home. We learned creativity is not only needed on the canvas or center stage, but in every corner of producing theatre this way.

When we finally were able to meet in person, we began navigating new challenges. Weather, flight paths, new technology, masks and sanitizer, traffic and animal noises. You name it and we faced it. Due to navigating rain, wind, and even snow in April the show you are about to see had only six in person rehearsals.

Despite all of these "unprecedented" circumstances, my hope for you our audience tonight goes past my usual desire that you enjoy the show. I hope that you experience the same hope, joy, and even teary eyes that I myself experienced watching these incredibly talented, resilient and unstoppable students perform. Hearing their voices, seeing them together, and watching this show unfold will forever be some of my proudest moments as director. As Dolly herself said "A better day is on the way..." Thank you now more than ever for your support of live theatre and please enjoy 9 to 5.
